5	North Richmondshire Community Coronavirus Support				
	JB provided an update on the work of the Community Support Organisation (CSO) for the area, The Bridge in Catterick. The CSO works closely with the Mutual Aid Groups that have been established in the areas to respond to local need. They co-ordinate support including shopping, prescriptions, befriending, welfare checks, hospital and GP appointments.				
	Initially at the start of the pandemic, the CSO were receiving on average 70 calls for help per week, this has now reduced to 20 per week as many people are using the support services and networks set up on a regular basis and it has become embedded as 'normal day to day life'. JB and the team are constantly scanning social media and other community news areas to seek out any vulnerable people that may need support. JB encouraged the group to refer people to the service.
