	JS provided an update on the work of the Community Support Organisation (CSC the area, The Upper Dales Community Partnership in Hawes. The CSO works clewith the Mutual Aid Groups that have been established in the areas to respond to need. They co-ordinate support including shopping, prescriptions, befriending, we checks, hospital and GP appointments. Initially at the start of the pandemic, the CSO were receiving around 65 calls for he per week, this has now reduced to approximately 20 as many people are using the support services and networks set up on a regular basis and it has become ember as 'normal day to day life'. The team are constantly scanning social media and oth community news areas to seek out any vulnerable people that may need support. Members are encouraged the group to refer people to the service.
