Sustainable Community Strategy Our Priorities for Richmondshire 2010 to 2015

Introduction

In this strategy we have identified our priorities for the next five years. These are the most important issues that the Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) wants to focus on over the next five years in order to fulfil our vision for the district which is:

'Richmondshire will be a place where people want to live, work and visit; where people enjoy a high quality of life and environment, feel safe, healthy and prosperous and have the opportunity to reach their full potential'

Although there are a number of issues that are important in the district, we have taken the decision as an LSP to concentrate only on those issues which no partner, organisation or group is able to take forward independently, or where it makes sense to take a collective approach. In this way we can be sure that the LSP plays an important role in dealing with the issues outlined in this document.

It is important however, that we still have sight of the other issues that communities in Richmondshire have raised. The principle ones are detailed below along with the name of the agency that is taking them forward:

- Facilities for young people North Yorkshire County Council, Richmondshire District Council
- Community safety The Richmondshire Community Safety Partnership
- Quality of the environment Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority / Richmondshire District Council
